**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PERCENTAGE OF COURSES TAUGHT
BY PART-TIME FACULTY AT THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY-
TECHNICAL COLLEGES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2024*) Not later than July 1, 2024,
2 the Board of Regents for Higher Education shall adopt a policy
3 concerning the percentage of courses that may be taught at the regional
4 community-technical colleges by part-time faculty. Such policy shall
5 permit (1) not more than forty-five per cent of such courses on and after
6 July 1, 2025, (2) not more than thirty-five per cent of such courses on and
7 after July 1, 2026, and (3) not more than twenty-five per cent of such
8 courses on and after July 1, 2027. As used in this section, "part-time
9 faculty" means a person appointed on a semester-by-semester basis to
10 teach a specific course or specific courses.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
