**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAWS OF THIS STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) There is established a working  
2 group to study the laws of criminal procedure of this state. Such study  
3 shall include, at a minimum, a review of title 54 of the general statutes  
4 for the purpose of recommending legislative changes to said title. The  
5 working group shall consist of the following members who have  
6 expertise in laws of criminal procedure: (1) One appointed by the  
7 speaker of the House of Representatives; (2) one appointed by the  
8 president pro tempore of the Senate; (3) one appointed by the majority  
9 leader of the House of Representatives; (4) one appointed by the  
10 majority leader of the Senate; (5) one appointed by the minority leader  
11 of the House of Representatives; and (6) one appointed by the minority  
12 leader of the Senate. Not later than January 1, 2024, the working group  
13 shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint  
14 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
15 matters relating to the judiciary, in accordance with the provisions of  
16 section 11-4a of the general statutes. The working group shall

17 terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 1, 2024,  
18 whichever is later.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
