***RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT CONCERNING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR STATE
SENATORS.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section 10 of article third of the Constitution of the state be
- 2 amended to increase the term of office for senators from two years to
- 3 four years, and to stagger the terms of senators so that half of the
- 4 membership of the senate is on the ballot at each state election.

Statement of Purpose:

To change the term of a state senator from two to four years and stagger the terms of senators.
