**"AN ACT CONCERNING VETERANS AND THE PASSPORT TO THE  
PARKS MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2023*) (a) The Office of Legislative  
4 Research, created under section 2-71c of the general statutes, shall:

5 (1) Review all provisions of the general statutes that authorize  
6 municipalities to enact property tax relief for veterans and members of  
7 the armed forces;

8 (2) Prepare a list of each municipality that has enacted such property  
9 tax relief, which list shall include details concerning such property tax  
10 offered by each municipality, such municipality's mill rate, exemption  
11 or abatement amount, qualifying income threshold, size of the grand list  
12 and median home value; and

13 (3) Identify the total number of veterans and members of the armed

14 forces in each municipality, including veterans who have a service-  
 15 connected disability rating by the United States Department of Veterans  
 16 Affairs amounting to one hundred per cent of total disability, and the  
 17 total number of such veterans and members who are eligible for such  
 18 property tax relief.

19 (b) Not later than December 1, 2023, the Office of Legislative Research  
 20 shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a  
 21 of the general statutes, on the items described in subdivisions (1) to (3),  
 22 inclusive, of subsection (a) of this section to the joint standing  
 23 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
 24 relating to veterans' and military affairs and municipal matters. As used  
 25 in this section, "veteran" and "armed forces" have the same meanings as  
 26 provided in section 27-103 of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2023	New section
