"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FROM THE HEALTHY HOMES FUND."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 8-446 of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2023*):

6 (1) Funding of not more than one million dollars, from remittances
7 transferred pursuant to section 38a-331 for the period beginning January
8 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, shall be remitted to the
9 Department of Economic and Community Development to be used for
10 grants-in-aid to homeowners with homes located in the immediate
11 vicinity of the West River in the Westville section of New Haven and

12 Woodbridge for structurally damaged homes due to subsidence and to
 13 homeowners with homes abutting the Yale Golf Course in the Westville
 14 section of New Haven for damage to such homes from water infiltration
 15 or structural damage due to subsidence, and, from remittances
 16 transferred pursuant to section 38a-331, for the period beginning May 1,
 17 2022, and ending April 30, 2023, funding not exceeding the actual cost
 18 of remediation or relocation shall be remitted to the Department of
 19 Housing to be used for grants-in-aid for the remediation of structurally
 20 deficient foundations in owner-occupied units or the relocation of any
 21 owner of any such unit of any condominium associations located in the
 22 town of Hamden;"
