"AN ACT CONCERNING STOP WORK ORDERS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2023*) The Labor Commissioner
4 shall employ not fewer than five wage and hour inspectors for the
5 purposes of enforcing the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this act.

6 Sec. 502. Subdivision (26) of subsection (b) of section 41 of house bill
7 6941 of the current session, as amended by House Amendment
8 Schedules "A" and "B", is repealed and the following is substituted in
9 lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

10 (26) The sum of [\$5,000,000] \$4,000,000 to the Department of Energy
11 and Environmental Protection, for Other Expenses, for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2024, for flood damage remediation;

13 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) Up to \$1,000,000 of the unexpended
14 balance of funds appropriated in section 1 of special act 21-15, as

15 amended by section 1 of public act 22-118, to the State Comptroller -
16 Fringe Benefits, for State Employees Health Service Cost, for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2023, shall not lapse on June 30, 2023, and such
18 funds shall be transferred to the Labor Department, for Personal
19 Services, and up to \$500,000 of such funds shall be made available
20 during each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024, and June 30, 2025,
21 for wage inspectors."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
