"AN ACT AMENDING CONNECTICUT PAID FAMILY MEDICAL LEAVE."

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- 1 In line 43, strike "a tribal enterprise or tribal government that has"
 - 2 Strike line 44 in its entirety
 - 3 In line 45, before "act" insert the following: "any federally recognized
 - 4 tribe that has entered into a memorandum of understanding pursuant
 - 5 to section 501 of this"
 - 6 In line 73, strike the opening and closing brackets
 - 7 In line 80, strike "; and" and insert a period in lieu thereof
 - 8 Strike lines 81 to 83, inclusive, in their entirety
 - 9 In line 130, after "(F)" insert "a physician assistant authorized to
 - 10 practice by the state in which such person practices and performs within
 - 11 the scope of the authorized practice; (G)"

12 In line 131, bracket "(E)" and after the closing bracket insert "(F)"

13 In line 134, bracket "(G)" and after the closing bracket insert "(H)"

14 Strike lines 174 to 180, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
15 following in lieu thereof:

16 "(2) On or after July 1, 2024, an employer-provided disability
17 insurance policy or self-administered salary continuation plan may
18 offset or coordinate benefits with compensation under this section only
19 to the extent compensation is actually paid under this section. No
20 employees shall be required to apply for compensation under this
21 section unless mandated by state or federal law."

22 Strike section 4 in its entirety

23 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
24 internal references accordingly:

25 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2023*) Notwithstanding the
26 provisions of section 3-6c of the general statutes, the Governor, in
27 consultation with the authority, may enter into a memorandum of
28 understanding with any federally recognized tribe located within the
29 state to authorize employees of both the tribe and any tribally owned
30 business to participate in the Family and Medical Leave Insurance
31 Program. Any such participation in the program shall be governed
32 solely by the terms of any memorandum of understanding entered into
33 pursuant to this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
