Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALES AND USE TAXES RATE AND THE IMPOSITION OF ON MEALS SOLD BY AN EATING ESTABLISHMENT, CATERER OR GROCERY STORE.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) require the rate of the sales and use taxes to be reduced annually to reflect the amount of increased revenue to the state attributable to inflation, and (2) eliminate the additional one per cent sales and use taxes imposed on meals sold by an eating establishment, caterer or grocery store.
