Title: AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION UNDER A WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIM.

Statement of Purpose: To require employers or insurers acting on behalf of employers to (1) provide notice of a proposed discontinuance or reduction of coverage of an employee's prescription medication, and (2) obtain approval before such discontinuance or reduction takes effect.
