Title: AN ACT CONCERNING NONCONSENSUAL TOWING.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) require the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to consider operating costs of the towing industry when establishing rates and charges for nonconsensual towing, (2) prohibit wreckers from charging for more than twenty miles of towing or transporting, (3) require wreckers to take one or more pictures of a motor vehicle prior to towing or transporting and accept payment by cash, check, credit card or debit card and provide change when appropriate, (4) require twenty-four-hour notice prior to removing a motor vehicle from private property, and (5) prohibit agreements between property owners and wreckers for the surveillance of property for the purpose of towing vehicles.
