**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR VETERANS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To (1) increase the dollar amounts of certain state-mandated property tax exemptions that are available to certain veterans or relatives of such veterans, (2) increase the dollar amounts of certain municipal option property tax exemptions that are available to certain veterans or relatives of such veterans, and (3) fully exempt from taxation the property of veterans with a one hundred per cent disability rating from the United States Department of Veteran Affairs.
