Title: AN ACT CONCERNING A DEFENDANT'S COMPETENCY TO STAND TRIAL AND EARLY RELEASE INTO THE COMMUNITY.

Statement of Purpose: To revise laws concerning defendants who are found not competent to stand trial and their early release into the community by providing for (1) better notice to victims and their families, (2) independent examinations, (3) an extension of the period of placement and monitoring under a placement order, and (4) one final exam before release.
