OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. It instead requires the Office of Legislative Research (OLR) to submit a report on municipal property tax relief for veterans and members of the armed forces, resulting in no fiscal impact as OLR has the expertise to meet the amendment's requirements.
