OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment lowers the age that an individual may apply for and be issued a pistol permit from 21 to 18, resulting in a potential revenue gain to the state and municipalities to the extent that more individuals apply for such permits. The amendment makes other various revisions to firearms permitting statutes not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact.
