### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***Cost***

The amendment requires the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to establish a grant program to fund the purchase of body armor to residents of the state, resulting in a cost to the state depending on the number of grants issued and the cost per grant. A set of body armor could cost anywhere from \$100 to \$1,000. It is unknown how many eligible residents would apply for such grants.
