The amendment eliminates a portion of the bill that creates several class B misdemeanors and class A misdemeanors which may result in a reduction in potential revenue gain from fines and potential cost from community supervision. The amendment also increases the circumstances of which a person may commit an infraction and be fined thirty-five dollars resulting in potential revenue gain.
