Explanation

The amendment establishes within the State Police, within the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, a state-wide firearms crimes task force to be comprised of state and municipal law enforcement officers, resulting in a potential cost to the state and municipal police departments to the extent that state and municipal law enforcement agencies choose to commit resources to the task force.
