No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill, replacing it with language that prevents the Departments of Public Health and Consumer Protection, the Commission of Pharmacy, health care institutions, and medical malpractice insurers from taking adverse actions against a health care provider due to adverse actions taken by another state because of a provider's provision of reproductive health care services that are permitted under Connecticut law, which does not result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities. It is not anticipated that these entities would choose to take adverse actions against health care providers for the provision of reproductive health care services in another state.
