Explanation

The strike-all amendment reduces the potential revenue gain to the state in the outyears (after the staff are brought on) to the extent a settlement or judgment is reached since it removes the provision contained in the underlying bill that anyone who violates the False Claims Act is liable to the state for investigation costs.
