OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Revenue Loss

The amendment makes several adjustments to the underlying bill including (1) reducing the applicability to state and locally funded libraries; (2) shifting the enacting date in FY 26; (3) removing the civil penalty attached to the bill.

The shifting of the enacting date could reduce savings in FY 26; and the removal of civil penalties could reduce potential revenue generated by the bill up to \$500 per violation.
