No Fiscal Impact

The amendment changes the number of police officers required in the underlying bill to obtain a risk warrant for children who pose an imminent risk of injuring other people and possess firearms or other deadly weapons from one to two¹ and makes clarifying changes, resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
