The amendment expands the circumstances outlined in the underlying bill under which municipal water pollution control authorities (WPCAs) may assign or enforce a lien on owner-occupied property. This increases the number of circumstances under which a municipal WPCA may collect debt and reduces the potential revenue loss a WPCA would realize as a result of the underlying bill.

It is anticipated that any revenue loss a WPCA realizes as a result of the underlying bill would be offset by increased sewer use fees and assessments on all users.
