#### ***Explanation***

The amendment creates a class D misdemeanor for using fish as prizes or for solicitation which results in a potential cost to the Judicial Department and a potential revenue gain from fines. On average, the marginal cost for supervision in the community is less than \$800<sup>1</sup> each year.
