No Fiscal Impact

The amendment excludes life insurance and annuity policy contracts in place before January 1, 2024, from the underlying bill's prohibition of denying such coverage solely on the basis of status as a first responder diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder. This does not change the fiscal impact of the underlying bill.
