No Fiscal Impact

The amendment replaces **Section 3** in the underlying bill with a provision that requires local dog kennels to be inspected annually by a municipal animal control officer (ACO). It allows the ACO to issue certain corrective orders, after consulting with a veterinarian, to fix any adverse conditions. This has no fiscal impact since it is expected that ACOs can inspect kennels within their existing resources.

Additionally, it specifies: (1) how local kennel license fees must be used by municipalities; and (2) requires a licensee to implement corrective orders at their expense to address any health concerns identified by the ACO.

These provisions have no fiscal impact since the amendment does not alter the allocation of fees to municipalities and requires the private, third-party licensee to pay for corrective orders.

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
