Explanation

The strike-all amendment requires any proposed revision to certain waste-related plans be submitted by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to the legislature for approval before its implementation. The section also establishes a process to follow if the committee rejects the proposal. This has no fiscal impact, as the legislature has sufficient resources for the additional responsibilities.
