**"RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE  
CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. That the following be proposed as an amendment to the  
4      Constitution of the State, which, when approved and adopted in the  
5      manner provided by the Constitution, shall, to all intents and purposes,  
6      become a part thereof:

7      Article sixth of the Constitution is amended by adding section 12 as  
8      follows:

9      Sec. 12. No person may mail an unsolicited application for an  
10     absentee ballot to any person.

11     RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the  
12     Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly  
13     elected at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024, and

14 published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented  
15 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024,  
16 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the amendments  
17 to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed amendment to be  
18 used on the ballots at such election shall be "Shall the Constitution of the  
19 State be amended to prohibit the unsolicited mailing of absentee ballot  
20 applications by any person?"
