"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT RETIREMENT SECURITY PROGRAM."

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- 1 In line 29, strike the opening bracket
 - 2 In line 30, strike the closing bracket and strike "sixty days"
 - 3 In line 119, strike the opening bracket
 - 4 In line 120, strike the closing bracket
 - 5 In line 121, strike ":" and strike the opening and closing brackets
 - 6 In line 121, bracket "2023" and after the closing bracket insert "2024"
 - 7 Strike lines 207 to 215, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
 - 8 following in lieu thereof:
 - 9 "(2) Not later than sixty days after a qualified employer provides
 - 10 informational materials to a covered employee in accordance with
 - 11 subsection (a) of this section, or such other time period as prescribed by

12 the Comptroller, and subject to the provisions of subdivision (3) of this
 13 subsection, such qualified employer shall, [automatically] upon receipt
 14 of written consent from a covered employee, enroll each of its covered
 15 employees that have provided consent to participate in the program at
 16 the participant's contribution level in accordance with the provisions of
 17 section 31-71j.

18 (3) A covered employee may opt out of the program at any time by
 19 electing a contribution level of zero."

20 Strike section 10 in its entirety and renumber the remaining sections
 21 and internal references accordingly

22 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 23 internal references accordingly:

24 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) The Comptroller shall deliver
 25 any written correspondence or communication to participants of the
 26 program by United States mail and provide an option for such
 27 participants to elect to receive such correspondence or communication
 28 by electronic means. Such correspondence or communication shall be
 29 marked clearly to indicate that it is an official document from the state.

30 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) Notwithstanding the
 31 provisions of chapters 62 and 62a of the general statutes, on or after July
 32 1, 2023, no state contracting agency shall enter into any contract with a
 33 business unless such contract contains a provision that requires such
 34 business to comply with the provisions of sections 42-515 to 42-525,
 35 inclusive, of the general statutes. For purposes of this section, "business",
 36 "contract" and "state contracting agency" have the same meanings as
 37 provided in section 4e-1 of the general statutes."
