"AN ACT CONCERNING COMPASSIONATE OR MEDICAL PAROLE AND CREDITS AWARDED FOR RELEASE DURING AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION AND SENTENCE COMMUTATIONS BY THE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1, 2024,
4 and annually thereafter, each member of the Board of Pardons and
5 Paroles shall complete at least two hours of training concerning how
6 victims are impacted by crime, the criminal justice process and the post-
7 conviction process. Such training may be provided by the Office of the
8 Victim Advocate, the Office of Victim Services of the Judicial Branch or
9 any other entity or organization that provides such training."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
