**"AN ACT CONCERNING COMPASSIONATE OR MEDICAL PAROLE
AND CREDITS AWARDED FOR RELEASE DURING AN
EMERGENCY DECLARATION AND SENTENCE COMMUTATIONS
BY THE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (j) of section 54-124a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (j) The chairperson, in consultation with the executive director, shall
7 adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54, concerning:

8 (1) Parole revocation and rescission hearings that include
9 implementing due process requirements;

10 (2) An expedited pardons review that allows an applicant convicted
11 of a crime to be granted a pardon with respect to such crime without a
12 hearing, unless a victim of such crime requests such a hearing, if such

13 applicant was convicted of a nonviolent crime;

14 (3) Requiring board members to issue written statements containing
15 the reasons for rejecting any application for a pardon; and

16 (4) The process for the commutation of sentences."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
