"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FROM THE HEALTHY HOMES FUND."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 8-446 of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):

6 (2) Funding a program or programs, and any related administrative
7 expense, to reduce health and safety hazards in residential dwellings in
8 Connecticut, including, but not limited to, (A) lead, radon and other
9 contaminants or conditions, through removal, remediation, abatement
10 and other appropriate methods, and (B) the remediation of structurally
11 deficient foundations in owner-occupied units, or the relocation of any
12 owner of any such unit, of any condominium associations located in the

13 town of Hamden. For purposes of this subdivision, "administrative
14 expense" means any administrative or other cost or expense incurred by
15 the Department of Housing in carrying out the provisions of this section,
16 including, but not limited to, the hiring of necessary employees and
17 entering into necessary contracts; and"
