



Substitute House Bill No. 5338

Special Act No. 24-22

AN ACT CONCERNING THE KIRKLYN M. KERR PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2024*) The University of Connecticut shall assess the feasibility of restarting the Kirklyn M. Kerr program, established pursuant to section 10a-19h of the general statutes, with a school of veterinary medicine that is accredited by the American Veterinary Medical Association. Not later than January 1, 2025, The University of Connecticut shall submit, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to higher education and employment advancement and appropriations and the budgets of state agencies a report on the feasibility and cost of restarting said program.
