Substitute House Bill No. 5430

*House of Representatives, April 18, 2024*

The Committee on Appropriations reported through REP. WALKER of the 93rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MIGRAINE TREATMENT FOR WOMEN AND VETERANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2024*) The University of Connecticut Health  
2 Center's Department of Neurology shall conduct a study of migraine  
3 treatment, specifically relating to treatment for women and veterans.  
4 Not later than July 1, 2026, the chair of said department shall report, in  
5 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
6 on the results of such study to the joint standing committees of the  
7 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public  
8 health and appropriations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>July 1, 2024</i>	New section
