AN ACT ADOPTING THE NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT.

Explanation

The bill, which requires multistate nursing license applicants¹ to be fingerprinted for criminal history checks, results in potential revenue gains (starting in FY 26 on 10/1/25) to the Applicant Fingerprint Card Submission account under the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP)² and municipal police departments.³ The magnitude of these potential revenue gains are dependent on the number of fingerprint checks performed by these entities due to the provisions of the bill.

The Out Years

¹Approved applicants will be licensed under a Nurse Licensure Compact, which the bill enters Connecticut into from 10/1/25 until 1/1/28.

²DESPP conducts fingerprinting for a fee of \$15 fee per person, which is paid to its Applicant Fingerprint Card Submission account.

³Municipal police departments may also conduct required fingerprinting and generally charge a fee of \$10 to \$15.

The fiscal impact identified above will continue subject to the number of multistate nursing license applicants fingerprinted by DESPP and municipal police departments from 7/1/26 until 1/1/28.
