Explanation

The bill does not result in a fiscal impact because the Department of Agriculture has the staff and expertise to complete a study on establishing a harvest season for the purpose of transporting agricultural products.

The bill also makes technical revisions to various statutes and repeals redundant statutes administered by the Department of Agriculture, which do not have a fiscal impact.

Senate "A" replaces section 4 of the underlying bill that establishes a year-round harvest season for vehicles transporting agricultural products and instead requires the Department of Agriculture study the need to establish an annual harvest season for the purposes of any vehicle that transports agricultural products. The change does not result in a fiscal impact.
