### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

***State Impact:*** None

### ***Explanation***

The bill, as amended, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities to establish a task force to study the prevention of undesired interactions between roaming swine and bovines as the task force members will have expertise in the subject area. The staff of the Environment Committee will serve as task force administrative staff.

The bill, as amended, is also not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities to (1) authorize animal control officers to seek court orders to enforce the law prohibiting roaming dogs or livestock and (2) require land proprietors to install fences to contain livestock.

Senate "A" adds the provision that (1) authorize animal control officers to seek court orders to enforce the law prohibiting roaming dogs or livestock and (2) require land proprietors to install fences to contain

livestock and results in the fiscal impact described above.
