***AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTIGATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE  
OFFICE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Not later than January 1, 2025, the  
2 Office of Early Childhood shall review, and revise as necessary, the  
3 codes used by the office to specify the nature or category of an  
4 investigation or disciplinary action, conducted pursuant to section 19a-  
5 80f, 19a-84, 19a-87a, 19a-87e, 19a-423 or 19a-429 of the general statutes,  
6 to assist the public in understanding and interpreting such codes.

7 (b) On and after January 1, 2025, the office shall use such revised  
8 codes for purposes of investigations and disciplinary actions pursuant  
9 to section 19a-80f, 19a-84, 19a-87a, 19a-87e, 19a-423 or 19a-429 of the  
10 general statutes.

11 (c) Not later than January 1, 2025, the office shall submit the codes  
12 described in subsection (b) of this section to the joint standing committee  
13 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
14 children in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general  
15 statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require the Office of Early Childhood to review and revise the codes used by the office to inform the public about the nature and outcome of certain investigations and disciplinary actions.
