***AN ACT REQUIRING STUDENT SURVEYS DURING EVALUATION OF  
A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL TO RENEW A CERTIFICATE OF  
AUTHORIZATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10a-22b of the general statutes is amended by  
2 adding subsection (h) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2024*):

3 (NEW) (h) Not later than January 1, 2025, the Office of Higher  
4 Education shall develop a survey to be completed by students of a  
5 private career school during an evaluation conducted pursuant to  
6 subsection (e) of this section for each private career school applying to  
7 renew its certificate of authorization pursuant to section 10a-22d. Such  
8 survey shall include, but need not be limited to, questions concerning  
9 (1) the quality of each course or program of instruction in which a  
10 student is or was enrolled, and (2) the ability of a student, upon  
11 completion of a program of study, to obtain the credential or licensing  
12 required to work in the occupation advertised by such private career  
13 school. Each evaluation team appointed pursuant to subsection (f) of  
14 this section on or after January 1, 2025, shall administer such survey to

15 students as part of its evaluation of a private career school.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	July 1, 2024	10a-22b(h)

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require student surveys as part of the evaluation of private career schools during the process for renewal of a certificate of authorization.
