**AN ACT EXEMPTING INFORMATION CONCERNING CERTAIN
VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE
FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 1-210 of the 2024 supplement to
2 the general statutes is amended by adding subdivisions (29) and (30) as
3 follows (*Effective October 1, 2024*):

4 (NEW) (29) Records of the Commission on Human Rights and
5 Opportunities of an investigation of alleged sexual harassment in
6 violation of subdivision (8) of subsection (b) of section 46a-60 or an
7 alleged discriminatory practice, as defined in section 46a-51, including
8 any complaint filed under section 46a-82 or the name of a person
9 providing information concerning such complaint, other than
10 disclosure to a party to the administrative hearing;

11 (NEW) (30) Records contained within the registry of residents of the
12 state with cognitive challenges created by the Division of State Police
13 within the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection for

14 purposes of assisting in the recovery of missing or wandering persons.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2024</i>	1-210(b)(29) and (30)

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act (1) records of an investigation or complaint of alleged sexual harassment or an alleged discriminatory practice or the name of a person providing information concerning such allegations, and (2) records contained within the registry of residents with cognitive challenges created by law enforcement for purposes of assisting in the recovery of missing or wandering persons.
