AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL RESOURCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) reallocate funds to be

- 3 maintenance by school districts, and (2) increase funding to Regional
- 4 Education Service Centers for the purpose of providing training to
