AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR INFRASTRUCTURE AND BUILDING REPAIRS AND EQUIPMENT FOR GEMMA E. MORAN UNITED WAY/LABOR FOOD CENTER IN NEW LONDON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 one million two hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall
- 5 be used by the Department of Economic and Community Development
- 6 for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the Gemma E. Moran
- 7 United Way/Labor Food Center in New London for infrastructure and
- 8 building repairs and equipment, including, but not limited to, delivery
- 9 vehicles, cold storage environments and forklifts.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for infrastructure and building repairs and equipment for the Gemma E. Moran United Way/Labor Food Center in New London.
