AN ACT REQUIRING A PLAN TO ESTABLISH A HOSPICE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1, 2025, the
2 Commissioner of Public Health shall (1) develop a plan to establish a
3 hospice program for children in the state, and (2) report, in accordance
4 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, regarding
5 such plan and the anticipated timeframe for implementation of such
6 plan to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
7 cognizance of matters relating to public health.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
