AN ACT CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Not later than October 1,
2 2022, and quarterly thereafter, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
3 Management shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of
4 section 11-4a of the general statutes, concerning the receipt and
5 expenditure of funds received by the state pursuant to the Infrastructure
6 Investment and Jobs Act, P.L. 117-58, as amended from time to time, to
7 the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
8 cognizance of matters relating to transportation, the environment,
9 government administration, appropriations and the budgets of state
10 agencies and finance, revenue and bonding. The secretary shall also post
11 each such report on the Internet web site of the Office of Policy and
12 Management.

13 (b) Not later than ten days after the submission of each such report,
14 each committee listed in subsection (a) of this section may hold a joint

15 public hearing on such report.

16 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
17 Transportation shall establish a separate page on the Internet web site
18 of the Department of Transportation dedicated to the receipt and
19 expenditure of funds received by the department pursuant to the
20 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, P.L. 117-58, as amended from
21 time to time.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require a quarterly report, public hearings and the posting of information on the Internet web site of the Department of Transportation regarding the receipt and expenditure of funds received pursuant to the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, P.L. 117-58.
