**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF MOUNT DECATUR AS
A HISTORIC SITE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than July 15, 2024, the State
2 Historic Preservation Review Board, established under section 10-321q
3 of the general statutes, shall nominate the portion of the site containing
4 the stone and earthwork fort from the War of 1812 located on Mount
5 Decatur, in the Gales Ferry section of the town of Ledyard, to be added
6 to the National Register of Historic Places, in accordance with the
7 provisions of section 10-321q of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
