



Substitute House Bill No. 5237

Public Act No. 24-116

AN ACT REQUIRING STUDENT SURVEYS DURING EVALUATION OF A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL TO RENEW A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 10a-22b of the general statutes is amended by adding subsection (h) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2024*):

(NEW) (h) Not later than January 1, 2025, the Office of Higher Education shall develop a survey to be completed by students of a private career school during an evaluation conducted pursuant to subsection (e) of this section for each private career school applying to renew its certificate of authorization pursuant to section 10a-22d. Such survey shall include, but need not be limited to, questions concerning the quality of each course or program of instruction in which a student is or was enrolled. Each evaluation team appointed pursuant to subsection (f) of this section on or after January 1, 2025, shall administer such survey to students as part of its evaluation of a private career school.
