"AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO THE PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE STATUTES."

1 Strike section 6 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 6. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2024*) Notwithstanding the
3 provisions of section 3-6c of the general statutes, the Governor, in
4 consultation with the authority, may enter into a memorandum of
5 understanding with any federally recognized tribe located within the
6 state to authorize employees of both the tribe and any tribally owned
7 business to participate in the Family and Medical Leave Insurance
8 Program. Any such participation in the program shall be governed
9 solely by the terms of any memorandum of understanding entered into
10 pursuant to this section. The terms of such memorandum of
11 understanding shall require participation to be under the same terms
12 and conditions other employees are subject to pursuant to sections 31-
13 49e to 31-49t, inclusive, of the general statutes and shall apply the same
14 terms and conditions for employers that other employers are subject to

15 pursuant to such sections."
