**"AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO THE PAID FAMILY AND
MEDICAL LEAVE STATUTES."**

- 1 In line 311, strike "enter into" and insert "negotiate" in lieu thereof
- 2 In line 315, after "Program." insert "Any such memorandum of
3 understanding shall be referred, without debate, to the joint standing
4 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
5 relating to labor. Such joint standing committee may, following a public
6 hearing, amend such memorandum of understanding and shall report
7 thereof within thirty legislative days from the time of reference, but no
8 later than seven legislative days before the adjourning of the General
9 Assembly. The General Assembly may approve such memorandum of
10 understanding, in whole, by a majority vote of each house or may reject
11 such memorandum of understanding, in whole by a majority vote of
12 either house. If rejected, such memorandum of understanding shall not
13 be valid and shall not be implemented. The memorandum of
14 understanding shall be deemed rejected if the General Assembly fails to
15 vote to approve or reject such memorandum of understanding (1) prior

16 to the adjournment of the regular session of the General Assembly
17 during which such memorandum of understanding is filed, (2) prior to
18 the adjournment of the regular session of the General Assembly first
19 following the date on which such memorandum is filed if the General
20 Assembly is not in regular session on such date, or (3) prior to the
21 adjournment of a special session convened before the next regular
22 session of the General Assembly for the purpose of considering such
23 memorandum of understanding if the General Assembly is not in
24 regular session on the date on which such memorandum of
25 understanding is filed, provided, if the memorandum of understanding
26 is filed less than thirty days before the end of a regular session, the
27 General Assembly may vote to approve or reject the memorandum of
28 understanding (A) within thirty days after the first day of a special
29 session convened before the next regular session of the General
30 Assembly for the purpose of considering such memorandum of
31 understanding, or (B) within thirty days after the first day of the next
32 regular session of the General Assembly."
