**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY PROCUREMENTS, CERTAIN ENERGY SOURCES AND PROGRAMS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY.

**Statement of Purpose:** To (1) permit the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to coordinate with other New England states to procure generation resources from a nuclear power generating facility for ten years following the end of existing agreements with a nuclear power generating facility; (2) authorize the electric distribution companies to use resources from a nuclear power generating facility to supply standard service if the procurement manager of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority approves; and (3) increase the maximum allowed contract length for wind procurements to thirty years.
