No Fiscal Impact

The amendment adds certain records concerning police officers to a list of records that are not required to be disclosed under the Freedom of Information Act and clarifies that if a chief law enforcement officer to have made a violation that the appointing authority is responsible to report to the Police Officer Standards and Training Council (POST). These changes are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or to municipalities.
