OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment prescribes a process for a person whose lien release requirements have been fully satisfied, to request discharge from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) within 60 days. As the process applies when all requirements, including the payment of any interest owed to DEEP, have been satisfied, the amendment's process will not impact state revenues.
